

# Global Impact Team (GIT)

## Ministry *CHAMPION* Job Description

Reports to: Ministry Area Heads

Summary: The GIT Champion serves as the link between the church and a specific ministry(ies) and/or missionary(ies), ensuring ongoing communication for prayer, support, care and involvement.

Responsibilities:

1. Serve as a liaison, link, go-between and connection between the church and a specific ministry(ies) and/or missionary(ies).
2. Communicate regularly with the ministry or missionary to provide updates on the church's life and ministry (perhaps by sending the church's newsletter, sermon tapes or mp3s, etc) and to receive regular reports/news/prayer requests from the ministry/missionary.
3. Channel prayer requests/answers to prayer from the ministry/missionary to the GIT Prayer Coordinator for distribution to the church family.
4. Ensure that any financial support committed by the church is being sent to the ministry/missionary.
5. Serve as an advocate to handle any problems/issues that may arise between the church and the ministry/missionary.
6. Help coordinate short-term trips from the church to the ministry/missionary. Training should be provided for this.
7. If possible, visit the ministry/missionary on their field of service once every two years to have first-hand exposure and connection with them.
8. Help coordinate visits by the ministry/missionary to the church during the GIC or at another time.
9. Pray for the ministry/missionary personally on a regular basis.
10. Represent the ministry/missionary to the church family as opportunities arise.
11. Provide updates regarding the ministry/missionary during meetings of the GIT and ministry area teams.
